1-Health & Safety:

- Use SAP PM to record maintenance activities, work orders and purchasing.
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- Perform PM routines on non-vendor supported equipment to meet the laboratory performance.
- Reduce equipment parts cost by improving procedures, exploring alternative part sources, and lifetime extensions of consumable parts.
- Utilize structured problem solving approach for complex equipment related issues.
- Verifies equipment information (including serial number, location, and status) in order to properly schedule work requests.
- Coordinates work order escalations, including, obtaining quotes, purchase orders, scheduling with vendors, and providing escort to instruments.
- Responsible for reviewing and implementing of yearly calibration plan for all instruments and equipment inside the labs.
- Provide specialist services to maintain, calibrate, and qualify specialized equipment.
- Contribute to Root Cause Analysis according to Lafarge standards.
